Stormin' to the Hoop Tournament Rules

Rules:

7 minute quarters. Clock stops on all dead balls. Bonus after 7 team fouls. Double bonus after 10 team fouls. Press: 4th, 5th grade: last 2 minutes of the game unless leading by more than 15 points.

6th-8th Grade: Press anytime unless leading by more than 20 points.

Technical Fouls: Automatic 2 points plus the ball, plus a personal foul will be assessed to the player receiving the technical foul. ANY COACH OR PLAYER RECEIVING 2 TECHNICAL FOULS IN ONE GAME WILL BE EJECTED FROM THE GAME AND SUSPENDED FOR THE FOLLOWING GAME. NO EXCEPTIONS.

3 Time Outs per game, 1 additional for each overtime.

Tie Breaker is head to head first and least points allowed second.

All decisions of the tournament officials are final----there are no protests allowed. Tournament officials have the right to shorten games if necessary. Forfeits: A team shall forfeit if they fail to arrive 15 minutes after the start time of the game. IHSA rules will apply in all other areas.
